U.S. EPA Emission Control Warranty Statement Non-Road and Stationary Large Spark-Ignited Engines Your Warranty Rights and Obligations

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Generac Power Systems, Inc. (Generac) are pleased to explain the Emission Control System Warranty (ECS Warranty) on your new engine. Generac will warrant the emission control system on your engine for the period of time listed below provided there has been no abuse, neglect, unapproved modification or improper maintenance of your engine. The emission control system on this engine includes all components whose failure would increase the emissions of any regulated pollutant.

Manufacturer's Warranty Coverage:

This ECS Warranty is valid for 3 years or 2500 hours of operation, whichever comes first. For high-cost warranted components, the ECS Warranty is valid for 5 years or 3500 hours of operation, whichever comes first. If, during the warranty period, any emission-related part on your engine is found to be defective in materials or workmanship, repairs or replacement will be performed by a Generac Authorized Warranty Service Dealer. The ECS Warranty begins on the date the engine is placed into service.

Owner's Warranty Responsibilities:

As the engine owner, you are responsible for the completion of all required maintenance as listed in your factory supplied Owner's Manual. For warranty purposes, Generac recommends that you retain all receipts covering maintenance on your engine, but Generac cannot deny warranty coverage solely due to the lack of receipts.

You should be aware that Generac may deny any and/or all warranty coverage or responsibility if your engine, or a part/component thereof, has failed due to abuse, neglect, improper maintenance, or unapproved modifications.

You are responsible for contacting a Generac Authorized Warranty Dealer as soon as a problem occurs.

IMPORTANT NOTE: This warranty statement explains your rights and obligations under the Emission Control System Warranty, which is provided to you by Generac pursuant to federal law. Note that this warranty shall not apply to any incidental, consequential or indirect damages caused by defects in materials or workmanship or any delay in repair or replacement of the defective part(s). This warranty is in place of all other warranties, expressed or implied. Specifically, Generac makes no other warranties as to the merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. Any implied warranties which are allowed by law, shall be limited in duration to the terms of the express warranty provided herein. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitation may not apply to you.

Warranty service can be performed only by a Generac Authorized Warranty Service Facility. When requesting warranty service, evidence must be presented showing the date the engine was originally placed into service.

Emission Control System Warranty

Emission Control System Warranty (ECS Warranty) for Non-road and Stationary Large Spark-Ignited Gaseous Fuel Engines:

- (a) Applicability: This warranty shall apply to Generac certified Non-road and Stationary Large Spark-Ignited Gaseous Fuel Engines. The ECS Warranty period shall begin on the date the new engine is originally placed into service, and shall continue for the lesser of:
 - (1) Three years, or in the case of high-cost warranted parts, five years.
 - (2) 2500 hours of engine operation, or in the case of high-cost warranted parts, 3500 hours of engine operation.
- (b) General Emissions Warranty Coverage: Generac warrants to the original, end-use purchaser/owner of the new engine and to each subsequent purchaser/owner that the ECS when installed was:
 - (1) Designed, built and equipped so as to conform with all applicable regulations; and
 - (2) Free from defects in materials and workmanship which cause the failure of a warranted part at any time during the ECS Warranty period.
- (c) The warranty on emissions-related parts will be interpreted as follows:
 - (1) Any warranted part that is not scheduled for replacement as required maintenance in the Owner's Manual shall be warranted for the ECS Warranty Period. If any such part fails during the ECS Warranty Period, it shall be repaired or replaced by Generac according to Subsection (4) below. Any such part repaired or replaced under the ECS Warranty shall be warranted for the remainder of the ECS Warranty Period.
 - (2) Any warranted part that is scheduled only for regular inspection as specified in the Owner's Manual shall be warranted for the ECS Warranty Period. A statement in the Owner's Manual to the effect of "repair or replace as necessary" shall not reduce the ECS Warranty Period. Any such part repaired or replaced under the ECS Warranty shall be warranted for the remainder of the ECS Warranty Period.
 - (3) Any warranted part that is scheduled for replacement as required maintenance in the Owner's Manual shall be warranted for the period of time prior to first scheduled replacement point for that part. If the part fails prior to the first scheduled replacement, the part shall be repaired or replaced by Generac according to Subsection (4) below. Any such exhaust emissions-related part repaired or replaced under the ECS warranty shall be warranted for the remainder of the period prior to the first scheduled replacement point for that part.
 - (4) Repair or replacement of any warranted, exhaust emissions-related part under this ECS Warranty shall be performed at no charge to the owner at a Generac Authorized Warranty Service Facility.
 - (5) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (4) above, warranty services or repairs must be provided at Generac Authorized Service Facilities.
 - (6) When the engine is inspected by a Generac Authorized Warranty Service Facility, the purchaser/owner shall not be held responsible for diagnostic costs if the repair is deemed warrantable.
 - (7) Throughout the ECS Warranty Period, Generac shall maintain a supply of warranted exhaust emission-related parts sufficient to meet the expected demand for such parts.
 - (8) Any Generac authorized and approved replacement parts may be used in the performance of any ECS Warranty maintenance or repairs and will be provided without charge to the purchaser/owner. Such use shall not reduce Generac ECS Warranty obligations.
 - (9) No modifications, other than those explicitly approved by Generac, may be made to the engine. Unapproved modifications void this ECS Warranty and shall be sufficient ground for disallowing an ECS Warranty claim.
 - (10) Generac shall not be held liable hereunder for failures of any non-authorized replacement parts, or failures of any authorized parts caused by the use of non-authorized replacement parts.
