(All ratings in accordance with BS5514, IS03046 and DIN6271). *Maximum kilovolt amps and current are subject to and limited by such factors as fuel BTU (megajoule) content, ambient temperature, altitude, engine power and condition, etc. Maximum power decreases about 3.5% for each 304.8 m (1,000 ft) above sea level; and also will decrease about 1% for each 6 °C (10 °F) above 16 °C (60 °F).





G007101-0	Battery Pad Warmer	The pad warmer rests under the battery. Recommended for use if the temperature regularly falls below -18 °C (0 °F). (Not necessary for use with AGM-style batteries).
G007102-0	Oil Warmer	Oil warmer slips directly over the oil filter. Recommended for use if the temperature regularly falls below -18 °C (0 °F).
G007027-0	Fascia Base Wrap Kit	The fascia base wrap snaps together around the bottom of the new air cooled generator sets. This offers a sleek, contoured appearance as well as offering protection from rodents and insects by covering the lifting holes located in the base.
G005703-0	Paint Kit	If the generator set enclosure is scratched or damaged, it is important to touch-up the paint to protect from future corrosion. The paint kit includes the necessary paint to correctly maintain or touch up a generator set enclosure.
